



2026 Alexandria Sportsman's Club Vocational Scholarship

For the second year in a row, the Alexandria Sportsman's Club will award scholarships for students who want to pursue vocational or technical education after graduating from high school. The purpose of this scholarship is to make education more accessible for students who want to gain specific skills and certifications for a trade or technical career.

Inspired by the late Marion Moon, two vocational scholarships of \$2,500 each will be awarded this spring to high school seniors in the City of Alexandria.

This scholarship will provide financial assistance for students who want to further their education in a trade at a qualified institution. The options are vast—from automotive repair, welding and electrical skills to culinary arts, cosmetology, logistics and so much more.

- Pathways to entrepreneurship
